

Case coordination is an approach to ending homelessness that facilitates a multi-agency response to people with complex needs. Case coordination includes fortnightly meetings where clients are referred who have given informed consent to this process.

From this meeting, plans are developed and agreed to deliver a mix of housing and support services to meet the client's unique needs.

Clients may benefit from case coordination if they require the assistance of two or more agencies, if their circumstances are complex and where multiple factors drive their homelessness or vulnerability to homelessness.

Referrals can be for individuals or households currently homeless or whose tenancy is at risk. Referring agencies then form part of the team response going forward.



Under 1 Roof

Vision

Under 1 Roof works to integrate service delivery to achieve an end to homelessness in Brisbane.

Aims:

- To offer a range of housing and support options to homeless people
- To provide comprehensive and integrated support for households to maintain their tenancies and participate fully in the community
- To contribute to the supply of social and affordable housing dwellings to meet the needs of individuals and families
- To improve access to services for homeless people through multiple contact points and no wrong door
- . To involve the whole community in ending homelessness
- To measure successes and evaluate outcomes with a focus on continuous improvements to service delivery.

Striving towards better practice...

Housing first

Homeless people are moved as quickly as possible into a long-term housing solution with wrap-around support, thus avoiding enculturation into homelessness.

Assertive outreach

Assertive outreach uses a persistent rather than passive style, with the intention of facilitating access to all available support services. Workers are mobile and access is also possible through various locations across the consortium. Assertive outreach continues as part of planned support to ensure that a person is supported to sustain their tenancy.

Tenancy sustainment

Under 1 Roof works to continuously improve practice so that interventions and case management provides holistic, recovery focused, long-term support. The primary purpose is to sustain housing outcomes through support and strengthen belonging as part of the solution to homelessness.

· A multi-agency response through case coordination

Under 1 Roof's multi-agency approach extends to a range of partners to deliver integrated and coordinated services geared to achieving sustained housing outcomes. Fortnightly case coordination meetings provide the mechanism for Under 1 Roof to identify opportunities for intervention and support, and to minimise service duplication.

What we offer

Across the Under 1 Roof Consortium, the following services and opportunities are available and may form part of an integrated support plan:

- · Specialised case management
- · Wrap-around multi-agency support
- · Supportive short-term, transitional and long-term housing options
- · Information, referral and advocacy
- · Common assessment to identify housing and support needs
- · Access to health and mental health services
- · Safety and support to recover from trauma and abuse
- Street outreach and multiple access points
- Harm reduction, information and advice
- Assistance to overcome substance dependency
- · Access to food packages, low-cost and free meals
- Community support and participation
- Social and recreational opportunities
- . Links to employment and training.

Learning and development

Under 1 Roof recognises that learning and development opportunities are essential in supporting good practice. Under 1 Roof has developed the following opportunities to support learning and development among agencies working to end homelessness.

The Synthesis Series: These are reflective practice sessions which explore questions and conundrums embedded within policies, practices and service delivery aimed at ending homelessness. The topics are drawn from Under 1 Roof's own work to pilot multiagency case coordination. These discussions debate important and sometimes complex issues that characterise responses to homelessness. The theme of synthesis highlights the challenge of transforming seemingly competing issues into deeper and more effective practice with a focus on ending homelessness.

Training: Under 1 Roof also offers training with a focus on key areas such as planned support, tenancy sustainment, case coordination and community development
